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2	<b>OBJECT OF THE CONTRACT</b>	
2.1	Title:	Procurement and Installation of the Baggage Handling System Enabling Works
2.2	Type of contract:	Project
2.3	Description:	<p>Athens International Airport S.A. (hereinafter called "AIA") in compliance with the Airport Development Agreement as ratified by Law 2338/1995 (Government Gazette A'202/14.09.95), is inviting companies or consortia/ joint ventures to tender for the "Procurement and Installation of the Baggage Handling System Enabling Works" (herein after referred to as the Project) at Athens International Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos".</p> <p>The scope of this Project includes the procurement, installation, testing, commissioning and handover of the BHS Enabling works that will facilitate the proposed reconfiguration of the existing bag halls of Athens international Airport for the future implementation of Std. 3 Hold Baggage Screening (HBS) technology. The enabling works will be implemented in 4 distinct areas, as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i) Transfer Baggage Facility</li> <li>ii) North Baggage Hall</li> <li>iii) South Wing Expansion</li> <li>iv) South Baggage Hall (Option)</li> </ul> <p>The requirements under the enabling works indicatively include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Design</li> <li>• Provision all conveyors and equipment</li> <li>• Install cable trays (containment) within the site boundaries for all BHS and HBS infrastructure</li> <li>• Provision of all power, electrical and controls to integrate the BHS and HBS</li> <li>• Connect EDS machines with dedicated power supply</li> <li>• Integrate EDS machines with BHS controls structure (including HBS network)</li> <li>• Undertake 'stand-alone' BHS controls SAT including bag tracking &amp; no reads</li> <li>• Integrated SAT of screening machines and associated equipment with the BHS</li> <li>• Validation testing of HBS system</li> <li>• Documentation and training for HBS / BHS operation</li> </ul> <p>More details are included in the Tender Documents which will be dispatched to the interested applicants.</p>

In addition, due to the restrictive conditions regarding the applicable time schedule, Tenderers shall provide a statement that they can and will abide by the time schedule set by AIA in the Tender Documents.

Their professional credentials and reliability, as well as their economic and financial ability under 4.2, and their technical capacity under 4.3, will be assessed on a go/ no-go basis.
