Background:

Inductus has received a service contract from two of the leading, nationally established & internationally acclaimed Infra Project Organizations at the various locations of the state of Rajasthan & Odisha.

To implement & deliver the project as per assigned Scope of Work (SOW) within the assigned timeline & framework, Inductus is looking for Sub-contractor/ Vendor/ Partner Organizations in the aforesaid two states.

Scope of Work:

The Contractor shall carry out all of his obligations under the Contract and shall perform the Work as per the Contract and Main Contract, with all due care and diligence and with the skill to be expected of a reputable Contractor experienced in the types of work to be carried out under the Contract. The Work shall be fit for the purposes specified in the Contract.

Contractor shall execute and complete the Works and remedy any defect therein as briefly mentioned in the Work Order and its Annexures and further detailed in Technical Specifications, drawings, annexures, attachments and other documents of the Contract/ Work Order.

Unless otherwise limited in the Work Order / Contract, Scope of Work includes provision of all manpower (direct and indirect), Plant & Machinery, Materials, other things and services at Site, whether of a temporary or permanent nature, so far as the necessity for providing the same is specified in or reasonably inferred from the Contract as required to successfully complete the Works within Time for Completion stipulated in the Work Order. Unless otherwise stipulated elsewhere in the Contract, Scope of Work includes the provision of all consumables, tools, tackles, lifting equipment, lubricants as required to execute and complete the Works.

Scope of Work includes the transportation/ handling of Materials, Plant & Machinery, manpower and other things whatsoever to and from site and within Site premises.

The Contractor shall, unless expressly excluded in the Contract from the Contractor's scope, perform all such services/work and provide all such Contractor's Equipment, manpower and Material at no additional cost to Inductus, though not specifically mentioned in the Contract but required for proper performance and attaining completion of Work in accordance with the Work Order / Contract, as if such services/work and provision of such Plant & Machinery and Material were expressly included in the Contractor's scope of work under the Contract.

Unless otherwise expressly limited and/or excluded elsewhere in the Contract from the scope, the Contractor's scope under the Contract shall be including but not limited to as described under following clauses:

INDUCTUS

- a. Provide highly skilled, skilled, semi-skilled, unskilled labour and qualified and experienced supervisory personnel. This includes providing all facilities for labour including labour camp, transportation, etc shall be borne by the Contractor.
- b. Make available all inspection and testing equipment.
- c. Construct and maintain temporary facilities like labour camps, site office, open and covered storage areas, fabrication yard (open and covered as required), access roads etc as required to carry out the construction.
- d. Construction power and water system - Water, electricity, Diesel Generators etc. as well as all utilities for the Contract shall be arranged by the Contractors at their own cost. This includes contacting the appropriate utility or service providers and applying for connections as necessary.
- e. Loading, unloading, handling, storage and preservation of Contractor's Equipment.
- f. Receiving and transporting Inductus'/Customer's Equipment and Materials to Contractor's store and/or Site for erection and installation.
- g. All civil, mechanical, electrical, instrumentation works as specified in the Contract.
- h. All painting and insulation works, as applicable.
- i. All applicable pre-commissioning activities such as air blowing, water flushing, steam blowing, chemical cleaning, no load runs, calibration of field instruments, calibration and testing of safety and control valves, testing of electrical equipment, functional and loop checks for electrical and instrumentation systems, lube oil filling, loading of catalyst and chemicals etc.
- j. Construction/ Execution management and supervision
- k. Construction/ Execution planning and scheduling of all the Works and related activities including resources under the scope of the Contractor to ensure completion of entire Work under its scope within the Completion Time.
- l. Assistance during commissioning and test runs including PG tests.
- m. Taking out insurances as per clause 23
- n. Coordination with its own Sub-contractors and other contractors working at Site
- o. Statutory clearances other than those obtained by the Owner and assistance in providing necessary drawings and documents etc, required by statutory authorities.
- p. Care and custody of Equipment and Materials issued to the Contractor
- q. Contractor and its subcontractors shall always maintain good housekeeping and shall keep all working and surrounding areas clean and free of obstructions/debris.
- r. Material reconciliation and Site clearance

Detailed Scope of Work (SOW), BOQ including Applicable Rates shall be provided to successful bidders post completion of EOI process.

Interested parties/companies meeting following criteria are requested to submit following documents as minimum.

1. The firm or entity should be a registered entity.
2. Valid Pan Registration Document.
3. Valid GST Registration Document.
4. Valid PF & ESIC Registration Documents.
5. Audited Balance Sheet of last two financial years.
6. Minimum three (03) years of experience (in preceding Five (05) years) in providing General Civil Works & Civil Maintenance services within the country.
7. Turnover in each of the immediately preceding two financial years should be 10 (Ten) Crores.
8. Positive net worth in each of the immediately preceding two financial years.
9. Letter of interest clearly indicating the project reference for the following locations:
 - a. Rajasthan
 - b. Odisha
 - c. Both a & b
10. Detail Company Information with Organisation structure Ownership details, List of manpower in Management, HSE and Construction Operations, details of resources available for carrying civil works (personnel and equipment).
11. Details of completion of similar type of projects in the last five years under headings:
 - a) Brief scope of work.
 - b) Value of work in INR
 - c) Contractual Duration
 - d) Actual completion of Project
 - e) Clients name
 - f) Contact details of the Client.
 - g) HSE statistics, LTI graph etc.
 - h) Location/s of work.
12. Bidder shall provide contract copies of major contracts executed in preceding five years.
13. Details of current commitments - List of all jobs under execution with the value of the Job and percentage completion.

Also, note:

- I. Normally standalone financials of the bidding entity only will be considered. However, consolidated financials at the bidding entity level, if available, can also be submitted. Parent company or Affiliate's financials can be submitted and considered, subject to submission of Parent/ Affiliate company guarantee. This should be clearly mentioned in the EoI response.

- II. Where the bidding entity is unable to meet the Financial Evaluation Criteria, Parent/Holding Company Audited Financials can be considered, subject to:
 - a. Submission of Financial guarantee in the form of 10% Bank guarantee of contract value.
 - b. Commitment Letter from Parent/Company to provide financial support to the bidding entity.
- III. Evaluation will be done only on the basis of the published annual reports / audited financials containing Auditor's report, Balance sheet, Profit & Loss a/c and Notes to Accounts.
- IV. In case of unaudited statements (if there are no audit requirements for auditing of financials as per the local law), the financials shall be accompanied by a certificate from a Certified Accountant. Certificate should also mention the fact that there is no requirement of audit of the financials as per the local law.
